WEEK 1 (JUNE 17-21) OPTIONS:

MORNING SESSIONS (8am-11am) Cost: \$90

Little Rangers (Session A1):

Come and explore the great outdoors! Learn about animal tracks, water cycles, eco-systems, by going hiking, fishing, and more! **Best for grades K-2. Limited to 12 participants.**

Bippity Boppity Build It! (Session B1):

Pasaporte Español (Session C1):

Campers will travel across South America and visit different Spanish speaking countries each day! This immersion adventure will explore the Spanish culture through language, art, cuisine, and more! **Great for grades 3-6. Limited to 15 participants.**

Kitchen 101 (Session D1):

Want to learn more about cooking? Join us for Kitchen 101 where campers will learn their way around the kitchen by learning to use kitchen tools and appliances, as well as learning a variety of cooking basics! **Great for grades 3-6. Limited to 15 participants.**

Wilderness Survival 101 (Session E1):

MORNING SESSIONS (8am-11am) Cost: \$90

Pasaporte Mexico! (Session A2)
